Start address:

1. Head west on University Blvd. toward Wellesley Ave. – 0.3 mi.
2. Turn left at OH-822 E/Brady Ave. Continue to follow OH-822 E – 0.6 mi.
3. Continue onto OH-43 N/Sunset Blvd. Continue to follow OH-43 N – 3.9 mi.
4. Continue straight onto Main St. – 0.3 mi.
5. Turn right at Canton Rd. – 0.3 mi.
6. Take the 2nd right onto Luray Dr. Destination will be on the left – 0.3 mi.
